



Speech at the Launch of 10th Anniversary Celebrations

At St. John the Evangelist Catholic Church on Sunday, August 19, 2018

Rev. Fathers, Beloved in Christ, today we stand before you as members of the Noble Order of the Knights and Ladies of Marshall of Adenta. Today, we come before you as a great example of the truth that in every human endeavor you should make a determined effort to start, to take the very first step and that you will never know how far God Almighty would carry you.

Ten years ago, come the month of September, some of us standing before you today announced to you the formation of Council 94 and Court 90 of the Noble Order of the Knights and Ladies of Marshall here at this our beloved parish. In these 10 years we have in our own small ways participated as a body in all church activities. As Marshallans we have through our actions, contributed to every physical development, participated in every spiritual event at church and at the individual levels. Over the last 10 years we have as Marshallan extended our modest efforts to the outstations of our parish as well as to neighboring social institutions including orphanages and mental hospitals. Over the same period we have grown our numbers from under 50 brothers and sisters to nearly 200 – this is how far the Lord has brought us!

Looking ahead, we come before you again to pledge ourselves to our motto of Unity, Charity, Fraternity and Service. By Unity we pledge our unconditional loyalty to, and belief in the Holy Mother, the Catholic Church and its leadership and especially its teachings on Faith and Morals; by Charity, Fraternity and Service we pledge our commitment to continue to be our neighbor's keeper in the true Samaritan spirit. These we pledge from our hearts to undertake with true Catholic devotion and commitment.

Rev Father, beloved in Christ, we plan to commemorate our decade of existence with a month long programme of activities with the theme: A decade of Marshallan Action at Adenta – Strengthening our Faith and Inspiring our Community.

We kick off our celebrations on Saturday 1st September, 2018 with a daylong retreat to reflect on our 10 years and to commit the entire celebrations into the hands of God.

The following day, Sunday, 2nd September, UNILIVER GHANA LIMITED will sponsor a Medical Outreach programme on Oral Hygiene here on these very grounds. This will be open to especially our children and so we shall encourage parents to note the date and bring along our precious ones to be examined, treated or given a referral to a hospital if necessary.

Come Sunday, 9th September we shall attend 2nd Mass to join our Junior Marshallans to celebrate their Feast Day, the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. After 10 years of existence, Council 94 and Court 90 of Adenta have the ambitious plan to construct our own Marshallan Resource Centre. We shall therefore after Mass that day cut the sod for work to commence on the construction of our Marshallan Temple at Amanfrom.

The date of consecration of Council 94 and Court 90, our birthday so to speak, falls on 20th September and so we shall have a Commemorative Mass in the evening of Thursday 20th September here at St John the Evangelist.

Beloved in Christ, the Noble Order of the Knights and Ladies of Marshall is synonymous with Charity Work so as part of our celebrations we shall spend a day with members of one of our outstations, St. Cecilia Catholic Church, Frafraha on Sunday September 23, 2018 and share a token of our love with them.

We crown the month long celebration of our 10th anniversary with a Thanksgiving Mass to the Glory of God Almighty on Sunday, 30th September, 2018 to be followed by a Fundraising Banquet on the grounds of SJECC.

The beauty of our month long celebrations is that as Catholics for each of the 6 planned events we celebrate the Holy Mass, the highest expression of prayer and so we invite each one of you to join us to celebrate a decade of Marshallan action!

Road To Consecration Of Council 94 And Court 90, Adenta

From Adenta Marshallan Association to Council And Court

THE STORY

Early Years

It must have been the spirit of Fraternity and Unity inculcated in us, for in 1999 the idea of the formation of the Adenta Marshallan Association came up, when a number of Marshallans from Council 63 and Court 58 found ourselves worshipping together at Assisi House, the birth place of St. John the Evangelist Catholic Church in Adenta. The interim Executives and other brothers and sisters included:

A number of external factors were also influential in the growth of the Association.

The most important was the rapid growth of the Catholic community at Adenta into its current status as a Quasi-Parish, a feat achieved over a very short period of five (5) years. As the Adenta community developed, and as the Catholic community at Adenta grew in tandem, typical church structures including the formation of societies began to take shape. The desire of Marshallans to carve a distinct identity and to be able to participate in Church programmes as a separate entity must have been one of the overriding influences on the pioneers of the Association. So when the Association formally registered with the Church at Adenta in year 2002 it allowed the association

- i) to be representation on the Parish Pastoral Council, and
- ii) to go on the roaster to clean the Church, take care of bidding prayers and offertory.

The second factor to influence the growth of the Association was the propaganda activities of Counicl 63 and Court 58 of the Noble Order of the Knights & Ladies of Marshall which saw the initiation of a number of brothers and sisters each year since 2000 culminating in the likelihood of initiating 12 brothers and 8 sisters that year alone.

Challenges

Like all pioneering efforts the formation and growth of the Marshallan Association at Adenta had its challenges. The frequent change of meeting place reflected some of the difficulties encountered by the group.

The Association's first place of meeting was at the Assisi House, a typical State Housing Corporation 3-bedroom house which was the birth place of the Catholic community at Adenta. It doubled as place of worship for the young community and meeting place for all the different associations. Frequent clashes for meeting space led to the Association moving to the residence of Brother and Sister Frimpong in year 2002 with meeting times rescheduled for the evening of each Sunday at 6:30 p.m.

For convenience and to improve attendance, the Association moved from its meeting place again to Brother Ken-Kwofie's residence which is a few metres away from the new Church premises. Meetings were then held on the first Sunday of every month after the first Mass. Finally with the completion of the Rev. Fr Van Hoof Nursery School building, the Association in 2007 relocated to the Church premises with the same meeting schedule.

There were also challenges in terms of allegiance and participation in programmes organized by the Church and the Noble Order. This was especially so in Lent with the Knights and Ladies of Marshall organizing the Easter Triduum at Madina and the Church at Adenta also organizing separate events.

Rejuvenation

For a while the Association's major role was organizing to undertake its periodic assignment of cleaning the Chapel and taking the Bidding Prayers and providing the Offertory. Then, in the middle of 2005 two enthusiastic sisters of the Marshallan Association, Sisters Anita Sankumah and Isabella Odartey-Wellington began canvassing for the rejuvenation of the Marshallan Association at Adenta.

Through their efforts regular meetings were held at Bro Ken Kwofie's residence and at one such meeting held in July 2005 the need for a Constitution to guide the Association was mooted. A 5-member Constitution Drafting Committee was set up, comprising

The Committee submitted its first draft on 4th September 2005 and this was finally accepted and adopted by the association on 18th September 2005. In fulfillment of the requirements of the Constitution, elections were held that same day and the following members were elected as substantive executives of the Adenta Marshallan Association. They included:

The officers were sworn into office by Rev. Fr. Anthony Opong on 19th January 2006, which date coincided with the Thanksgiving Mass for the installation of the then Bro. Michael Xatse and Sister Celestine Kanda, Grand Knight of Council 63 and Noble Lady of Court 58 respectively.

The Road to Consecration

In year 2007, after successfully running as a properly installed and registered society of the St John the Evangelist Catholic Church for a full year, the possibility of consecrating council and court at Adenta was discussed more frequently at the regular monthly meetings of the Association.

On 2nd September 2007 the decision was taken to seek guidance and general discussions on how to prepare for the consecration of Council and Court at Adenta.

At a historic meeting of the Adenta Marshallan Association held on Sunday, 7th October, 2007, Sister Bellona Vittor Quao moved for the adoption of a resolution to form Council and Court at Adenta within the shortest possible time. The motion was seconded by Sister Anita Sankumah. The resolution was adopted by popular acclamation at exactly 1:30 p.m. on Sunday, 7th October 2007.

The Association then plunged immediately into action with the establishment of the following organizing committees towards the consecration of Council and Court at Adenta. These included:


- 1. The Steering Committee, Chaired by Sir Kt Bro. Turkson

- 5. Liturgical Subcommittee, Chaired by Bro. Sumah, and
- 6. Membership Subcommittee, Chaired by Bro. Owusu-Akowuah

Our Sponsoring Council, Council 63, Madina also set up a Special Committee for the Consecration of Council under the chairmanship of Sir Kt Bro Peter Ainoo Hasford to provide general guidance. It was through the many and varied efforts of the above mentioned Committees and Subcommittees, the entire membership of the Marshallan Association at Adenta, the sponsoring Council and Court of Madina, and the hierarchy of the Noble Order that we are today, 20th September 2008 witnesses to the birth of a new Council 94 and Court 90 of the Noble Order at Adenta.







ROAD TO CONSECRATION OF JUNIOR ORDER

In the year 2014, Council 94 and Court 90 of the Knights and Ladies of Marshall, Adenta, under the administration of Brother Joseph Acheampong, Grand Knight, and Sister Anita Sankumah, Noble Lady, resolved to form a Junior Order. This decision was seen as one of the activities to celebrate the 5th anniversary of the consecration of Council 94 and Court 90.

A Joint Committee was put forward with Worthy Brother Gabriel G.H. Dari as Chairman and Sister Perpetual Konner Archer as Vice Chairman with the advisory support of Sister Belona Gerard Vittor-Quao. Through the committed and dedicated work of all the members of the committee, the major preparatory activities and requirements were successfully carried out. These included the following:

- 1. Identification and counselling of potential junior members
- 2. Seeking approval from the Supreme Council
- 3. Choosing a Sponsoring Council and Court
- 4. Assembling the required ritualistic articles and paraphernalia
- 5. Choosing a name for the Junior Order
- 6. Drawing the programme
- 7. Drawing a budget and sourcing for funding

Council 63 and Court 58, Madina, graciously accepted to be our sponsors and assigned their Junior Order 41J to serve as our mentors.

Having fulfilled the requirements set by the Supreme Council, approval was granted for the consecration of the Adenta Junior Order on Saturday, September 20th, 2014.

The Initiation, Installation and Consecration Committee therefore took place on 20th September, 2014, in the Old Chapel of the St John the Evangelist Catholic Church in Adenta.

The Initiation, Installation and Consecration team was made up of the following officers:

- 4. Bro Rev. Fr. Bonaventure Quaidoo, Assitant Parish Priest of St John The Evangelist Catholic Church Consecration Chaplain.

the Initiation, Installation and consecration was however preceded by a Junior Council Meeting and Court meeting of 41J Virgin Most Pure of Madina, the monitoring Junior Order. The meeting was then constituted for initiation at which 50 junior members from Adenta, made up of 24 junior brothers and 26 junior sisters were duly initiated. Council and Court was then re-constituted for initiation and consecrated.

The installation and consecration was successfully carried out and the Junior Order, 79J Mother Most Perfect, Adenta, was constitutionally and legally established.

This grand occasion was witnessed by 110 Senior Brothers and Sisters from Council 94 and Court 90 Adenta and other component Councils and Courts including the Supreme Knight, Sir Knight Bro Joseph Ekow Paintsil, Sir Knight Bro S.S. Turkson of blessed memory of council 94, W/Bro Michael Kwarteng, Immediate Past Regional Grand Knight Of Accra

East Region, W/Bro Samuel Kingsford Arthur, Regional Grand Knight of Accra East Region, Bro Joseph Acheampong, Grand Knight, Council 94, Sister Anita Sankumah, Noble Lady of Court 90, Adenta, Sister Angela Boakye-Acheampong, Noble Lady of Court 5, Accra, Sister Cynthia Holme-Alorbi, Noble Lady of Court 58, Madina.

DONATIONS: Various donations in kind and cash were made by several brothers and sisters from Council 94 and Court 90 and other component courts and councils towards the successful consecration of the Junior Order.

THANKSGIVING MASS: A thanksgiving mass was subsequently held on Sunday to thank God Almighty for a very successful consecration. Glory be to God and the Blessed Virgin Mary for making it possible for the formation of the Adenta Junior Order 79J, Mother Most Perfect.



TEMPLE PROJECT

The quest for a permanent place of meeting has plagued Council and Court since inception. In the early years important functions such as our Consecration and the subsequent four Installation ceremonies had to be held at Queen of Peace School, the meeting place for Council 63 and Court 58, Madina. Between April and October 2009, Council had to move its meeting place to Holy Rosary School at Adenta. Over the last decade we can count 3 separate locations within the St John the Evangelist church as our meeting place as we have had to make way for other needs of the Parish for use of same facility. We moved into our current meeting place in mid-2013. With increasing competition for use of existing facilities as the requirements for the newly established Nursery and Primary Schools increased, the need for a permanent solution for our meetings therefore became a matter of urgency and was always on our minds.

A number of significant events stretching from 2014 to 2015 may collectively serve as triggers or key factors that set the Noble Order at Adenta on the firm journey to build its own Temple. First, was an invitation from Council 63 and Court 58, Madina for a joint Temple project in January 2014 during the administration of Grand Knight Bro. Joe Acheampong. The frustrations of this joint effort which was on the agenda for nearly the whole of 2014 pushed the Noble Order at Adenta faster to the decision to go on its own. The second significant developments were three (3) separate donations by now Sir Kt. Bro. Dr. Nartey. He first donated GHS10,000.00 for the purchase of land for the temple. This was announced at the 2014 July Advisory Board Meeting. Then at the 2014 September Advisory Board Meeting, G.K. Bro. Joe Acheampong announced that Sir Kt. Bro Dr. Nartey was willing to also donate one of his SHC land at Adenta for the temple project. However negotiations fell through by November 2014 because the parties could not agree suitable terms. Failing this, Sir Kt. Bro. Dr. Nartey, still keen to support the temple project, in December 2014 made a second GHS10,000.00 towards the purchase of land for the temple. The other significant development in 2014 was the decision in the course of that year to look for our own parcel of land, especially Bro Addo-Tawiah's initiative to use District Surveyors to lead the search. He specifically made contact with the District Surveyor of Oyarifa. The last

significant factor on the journey to acquiring our own temple was the institutionalization of the temple project process during the 4th administration under Grand Knight Bro. Tom Mawusi, when a structured approach to fund raising and the setting up of the 1st Temple Planning Committee, chaired by then IPGK Bro Joe Acheampong were constituted.

The first parcel of land that the Order got sometime in 2014 was very conveniently located as it was just adjacent to the church premises but was not taken up eventually for 2 reasons. The price was too high at GHS100,000.00 per plot of 70 feet by 100 feet and in addition the parcel of land had some significant engineering difficulties which would have required additional funds to remedy as the land was in a natural drainage and was waterlogged for significant period during the rainy season.


The search for a suitable and affordable piece of land led the W/Bro Edwin Addo-Tawiah team to Amanfro where they obtained for the Noble Order a five plot parcel of land measuring nearly 1 acre (0.93 acre) at a total cost of GHC180,000.00 (i.e. GHS36,000.00 per plot). This was in 2015 during the 4th Administration of Grand Knight Bro, Tom Mawusi.

The newly found land was considered suitable but the challenge was how to raise sufficient funds to make the initial payments to secure it and keep away from other interests.


Brothers and sisters were levied to raise enough funds to make the initial payment of GHS60,000.00 on 29th February 2016.

Again two remarkable acts of philanthropy by Sir Kt. Bro. Dr. Daniel Nartey are worth mentioning without which we may be still struggling to make full payment for the land. First he made an additional payment of GHS13,000.00 bringing his total voluntary contributions to GHS33,000.00. In addition he gave the Noble Order a loan of GHS40,000.00 on very concessionary terms. The Noble Order of the Knights and Ladies of Marshallan, Adenta is eternally grateful to Sir Kt. Bro. Dr. Daniel Nartey for his significant contributions. Full payment for the land was completed with the settlement of the outstanding balance of Ghc10, 000.00 on September 04, 2018. Full documentation for title to the Land is under preparation.

The Noble Order continues to raise funds towards the fulfillment of our dream of a dedicated Temple for the Noble Order of Adenta. The official sod cutting to commence physical work on the Temple Project was jointly carried out by Grand Knight, Bro Paul Cletus Akpanya, Noble Lady, Sister Janet Seyram Vordzorgbe, the Accra East Regional Grand Knight W/bro Augustine Appiah, the Accra East Regional Noble Lady, RL sister Winnifred Yennah, the Supreme Knight, Sir Kt. Bro. Ambrose Yennah, AE Regional G.K, W/ bro Augustine Appiah, AE Regional NL, RL Sis and Rev. Fr. Eric Asagba on 9th September 2018.
