to assuage the emotional and psychological expressions of the group.

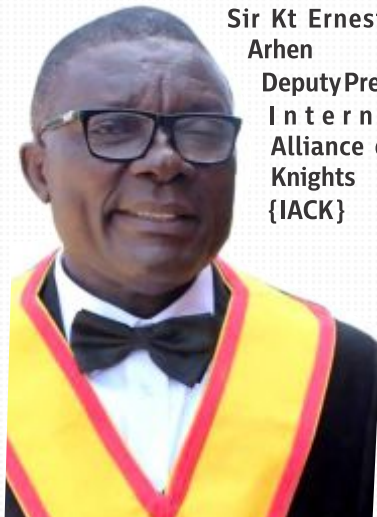
