



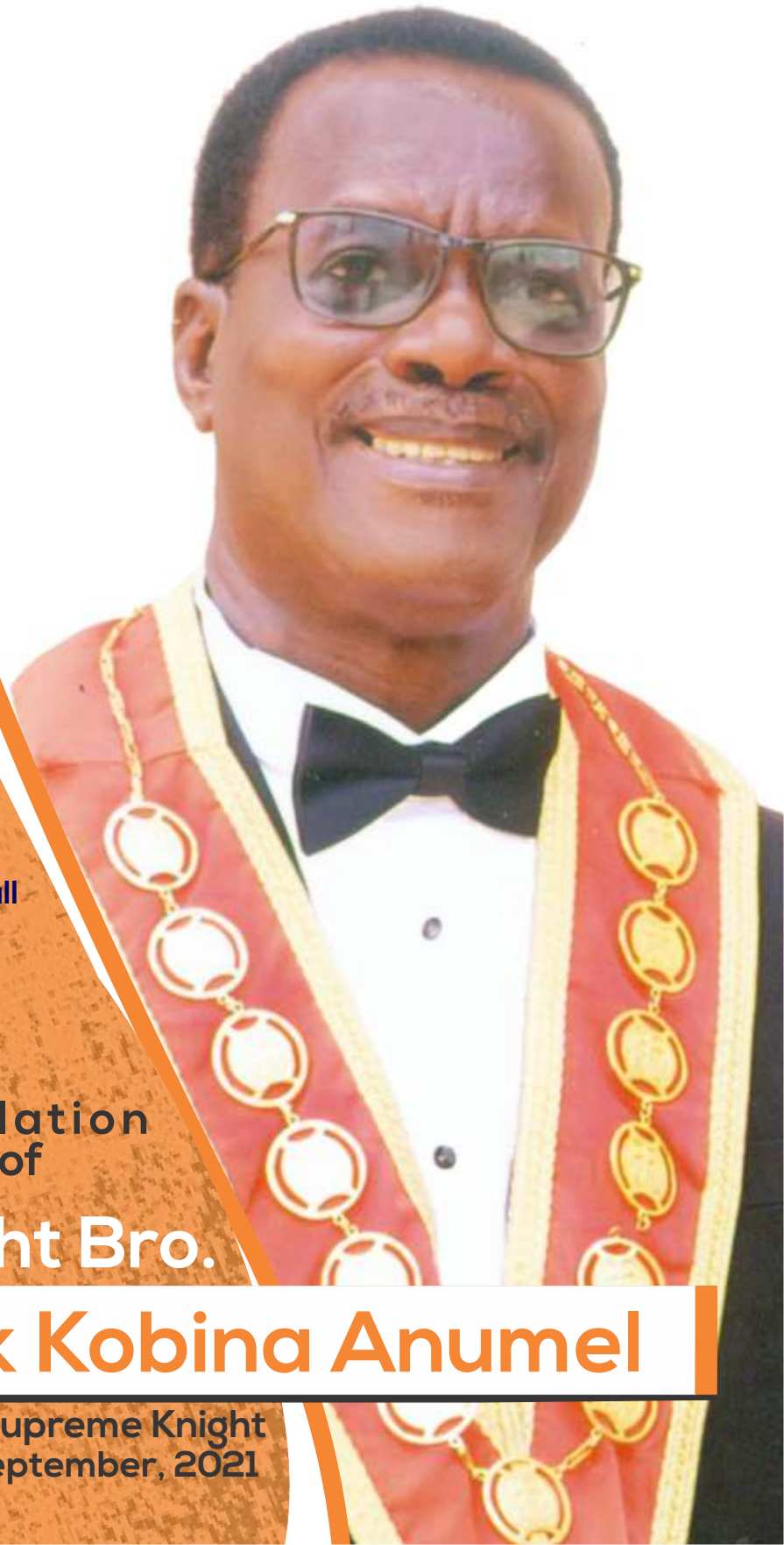

INSTALLATION SPEECH

Vision without action is a daydream, action without vision is a nightmare. Planning is essential. But action is what brings result. (Anonymous).

Supreme Director, Supreme Spiritual Director, my Lord Bishops and priests here gathered, SPSKs, SPGLs, Sir Knights, MRLs, W/Bros, RLs, Bro GKs; true, true, this is the day the Lord has made and we shall rejoice and be glad in it.

My journey in the Marshallan Fraternity started in July 1985 after our wedding ceremony in December, 1984, when my mother council (i.e. Council 45, Akosombo) was only two and half years old. Little did I know that I would get that close to the throne of Supreme Knight in 34 years when I was elected and installed Deputy Supreme Knight in 2019. Two years later, by the grace of God, I have been installed the 34th Supreme Knight of our Noble Order. This, I believe, is the work of the Lord and I accept this position with all humility. I believe and have strong faith that by the power of the Holy Spirit I will be able to execute this mandate with humility and divinely-guided competence.

Sir James Marshall

MA, BL, KT. CMG, KCSG

Born: 18/12/1829, Edinburgh.

Parentage: Father - a Presbyterian Minister who converted in 1841 to the Anglican Church. Mother - a housewife.

Disabled: Through an accidental gunshot in 1845 at age 16, Sir James Marshall had his right arm amputated.

Education: Oxford University for a degree in 1847 at age 18.

Appointment: 1852- Anglican Minister (Curate) at Trysull.

1854 - Anglican Minister (Curate) at St. Bartholomew, London.

Conversion: 21/11/1857 - Converted from an Ordained Minister of the Anglican Church to a Layman in the Catholic Church (By Rev. Fr. Robert Coffin, later Bishop Coffin).

Further Education: Read Law and called to the Bar at Middle Temple in 1868 (Lincoln's Inn).

Appointment: 1873 - Chief Magistrate and Judicial Assessor of the Gold Coast.

Marriage: Married in 1877 to Alice Young and blessed with two children.

Appointment: 1879, Chief Justice for British West Africa (Ghana and Nigeria).

Missionary Zeal: - Worked hard for the re-establishment of the Catholic Church in Ghana. Was instrumental in Rev. Frs. Auguste Moreau and Eugene Murat (SMA) coming to the Gold Coast on 18/05/1880.

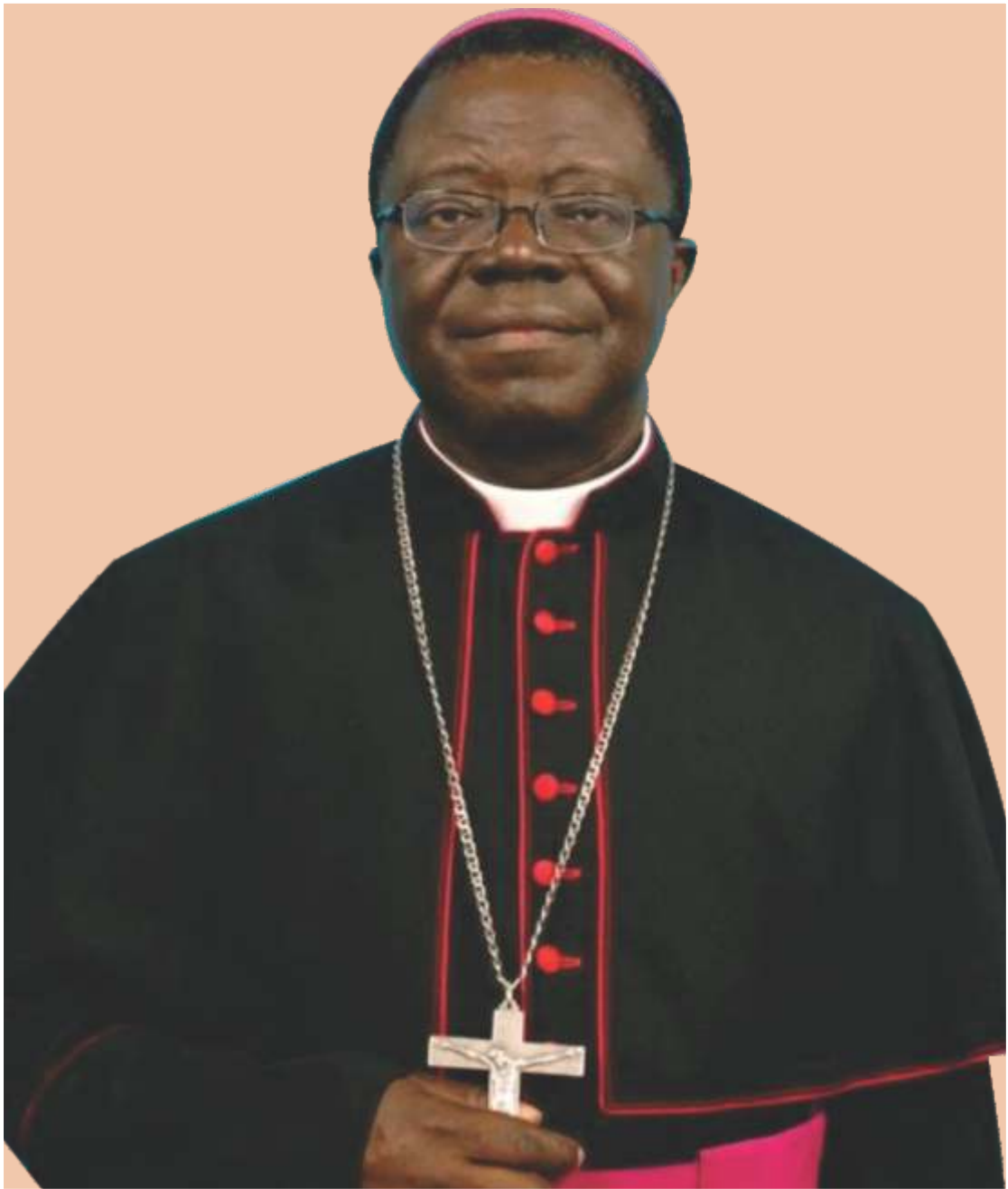
Knighthood: 29/06/1882 - Knighted, KT. CMG, KCMG by Queen Victoria of Great Britain. Knight Commander of the Order of St. Gregory (KCSG) by Pope Leo XIII in Rome - 20/01/1889.

Appointment: Chief Justice of Nigeria 1887 - Declined due to ill health but helped to establish the Judicial System in Nigeria.

Death: 09/08/1889 at Margate and buried at Mortlake, London.

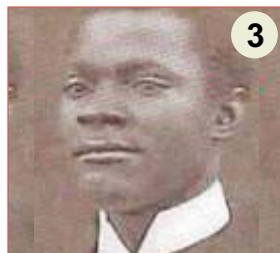

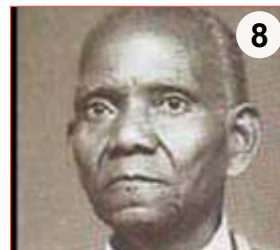

Installation of Sir Kt Bro. Patrick Kobina Anumel as 34th Supreme Knight

Adult Council Level

Sir Knight Bro Patrick Kobina Anumel joined the Noble Order of the Knights of Marshall in July, 1985 at Council 45. Akosombo. He was appointed the Organist and later became Secretary of Finance, Deputy Grand Knight and finally the Grand Knight in 1995.

Regional Council Level

At the regional level, Sir Knight Bro. Anumel held a number of positions in the Eastern Region (now named Koforidua Region after Koforidua Diocese), including Regional Secretary of Finance, Regional Auditor, Deputy Regional Grand Knight and finally Regional Grand Knight (RGK) in 2012.

During his reign as the RGK he arranged and acquired an office accommodation, furniture, laptop computer, printer, filing cabinet and floor carpet for the Eastern Regional Council and Court in Koforidua.

He introduced a two-day residential Training-of-Trainers Course in Mystic Psychology for Readers and Lecturers at the regional level and arranged for the Supreme Reader and Examiner and his Team to be the main resource personnel. He also arranged and organized a Special Workshop for the Guards in the Eastern Region with the Supreme Guard as the Resource personnel.

Supreme Council Level

As a member of the Standing Committee of the Supreme Council, he was appointed Chairman of the Marshallan Investment Fund (MIF) in its transformational stages in 2015 and later became the Chairman of MaSIF (Marshallan Savings and Investment Fund) in 2016. In September, 2017, he was appointed the Chairman of the Joint Committee of Finance and Investment of the Supreme Council and Grand Court.

Sir Knight Bro. Anumel was later appointed the Acting CEO of the Marshallan Company called Equity Development Consortium (EDeC), Member/Advisor of the MaSIF Management Committee and a member of the Strategic Planning Implementation Committee.

He was elected and installed the Deputy Supreme Knight on September 14, 2019 and the 34th Supreme Knight on 25th September, 2021.

Church Activities

Sir Knight Bro. Anumel has been Organist/Choirmaster in various parishes, including Christ the King Catholic Cathedral in Sunyani, Santa Barbara Catholic Church in Akosombo, and Corpus Christ Catholic Church in

Sakumono. He has also been Parish Counsellor and Marriage Counsellor.

Career Development

Sir Knight Bro Patrick Kobina Anumel is currently the Chairman of Pataraa Group of companies, a privately-owned organisation involved in Financial Management Consultancy, Agribusiness and Events Organization.

Patrick joined the erstwhile First National Savings and Loans Company as CEO in 2012 with a mandate to transform it into a universal bank. He accomplished this feat in 2014, changing the name of the company to GN Bank and retiring the following year in December, 2015.

Prior to this, he was the CEO of International Bank (Liberia) Limited, an American-owned bank in Liberia from 2007 to 2012. He was also the General Manager (Retail Banking) at CAL Bank after he was promoted from his previous position as Head of Banking Services Department of the same Bank. Patrick started his banking career at Agricultural Development Bank in 1978 as a Credit Officer and rose through the ranks to become a Branch Manager and later a Senior Manager before leaving for CAL Bank to take up the position of Head of Banking Services.

Professional Associations

Sir Knight Bro. Anumel served as the Vice-President and later the President of Liberia Bankers' Association. He is a member of Ghana Association of Consultants and a Fellow of Institute of Directors, Ghana. He is also a Director of SIB Bank (Liberia) Limited and a Director of Winneba Youth Choir.

Sir Knight Bro. Patrick Anumel was trained in banking by HSBC Bank in London, Citibank in Kenya, former Economic Development Institute (EDI) of the World Bank in South Africa. He has attended a number of international workshops, seminars and conferences relating to Banking and Finance, and Administration/Management. Sir Kt. Bro. Anumel obtained his bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of Ghana, Legon.

Directeur Suprême, Directeur Spirituel Suprême, Mes Seigneurs Evêques et autres prêtres ici présents, Passé Chevaliers Suprêmes titulaires, Passé Grandes Dames titulaires, Sires Chevaliers, Très Respectables Dames, Honorables Frères, Respectables Dames, Frères Grands Chevaliers; en vérité, en vérité, voilà le jour consacré par le Seigneur, nous devons nous en réjouir et en être heureux.
